

The Talent Project Task Force met at North Star Marketing on June 16 to hear the findings and recommendations from the research phase for an Alamance County Talent Retention and Attraction initiative. Staff will begin an analysis and prioritization of the recommended components. If you want to learn more, contact Andrea Fleming.

The Eastern Triad Workforce Initiative Phase 2 request for funding is currently still in the General Assembly budget. For the moment the two-year, \$4.5 million proposal has \$875,000 allocated to Alamance County. Funds will be used to continue programs and initiatives from Phase 1 including marketing and promotions for apprenticeship programs and funding for on-the-job and incumbent worker training, as well as adding funding for enhanced coordination with Junior Achievement and improving connections and support for Veteran employment.
