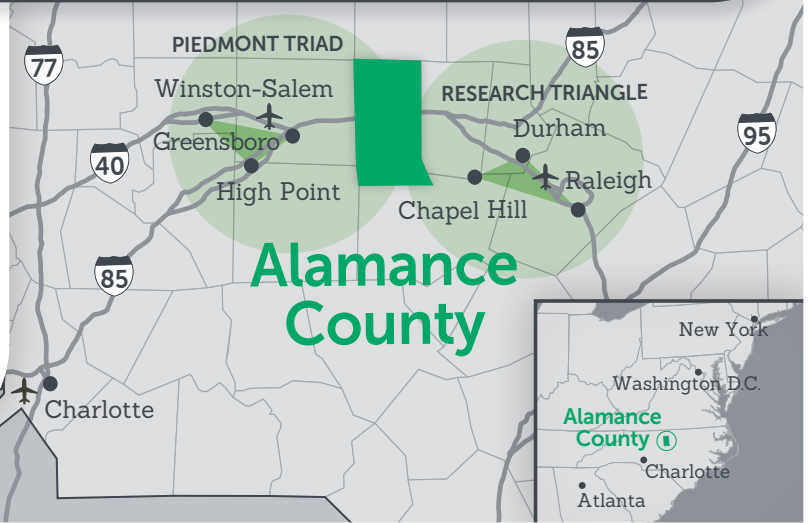

Alamance County is made up of numerous small towns, with Burlington as the largest municipality and Graham as the county seat.

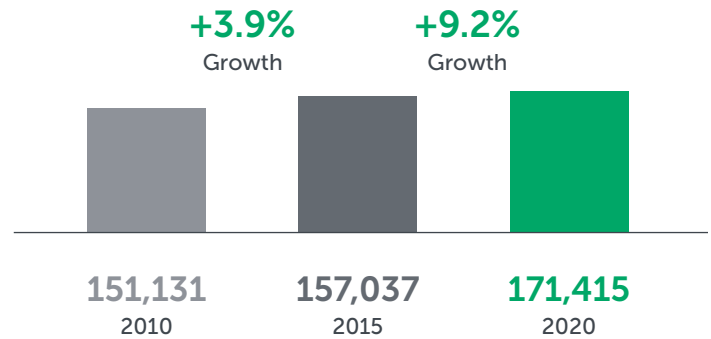

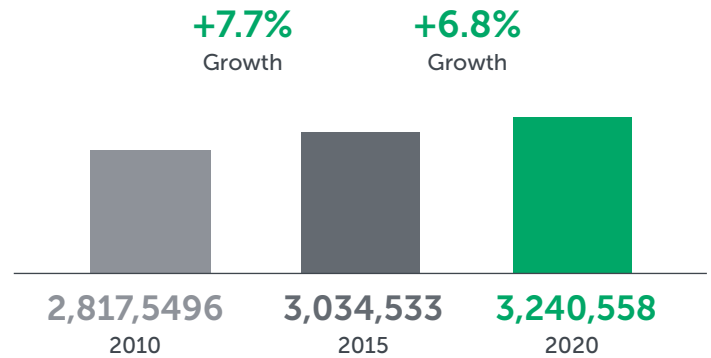

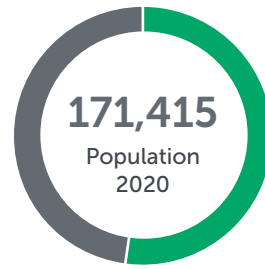

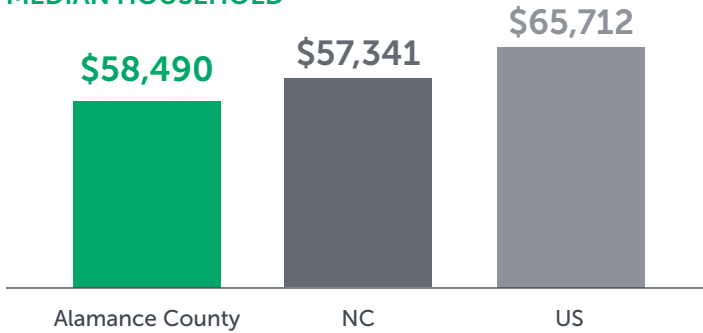

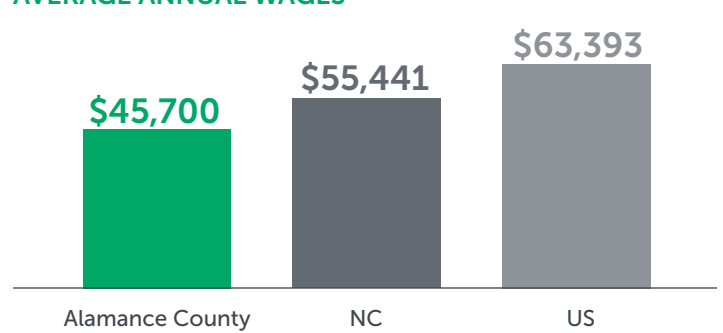
MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME AND WAGES

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD



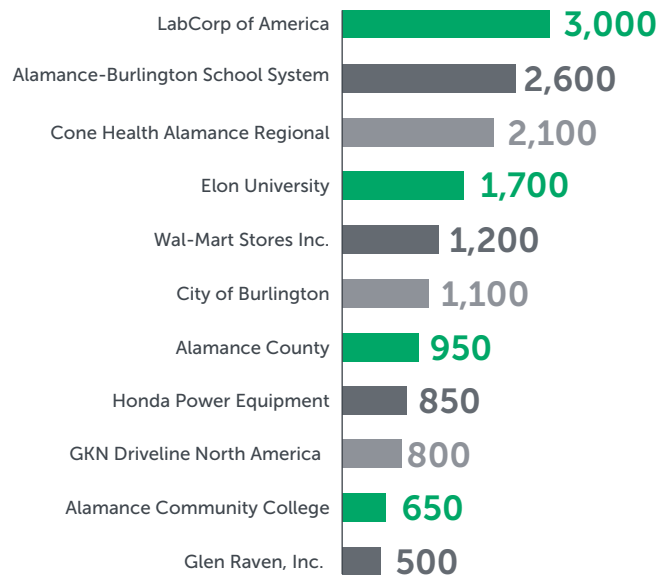

AVERAGE ANNUAL WAGES



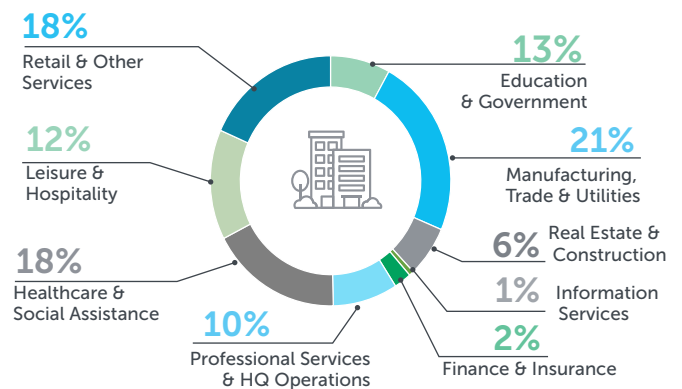
