## 22nd Annual campaign will run: **July 14 - August 11, 2023**

Organized by the Alamance Chamber, this campaign is designed to support students by supplying items needed for a successful school year. Many families struggle to make ends meet, and recent circumstances have only increased that need. Currently, **approximately 52%** of students enrolled in Alamance-Burlington Schools receive free or reduced breakfast/lunch and **11 schools** provide every student with free breakfast/lunch. The supplies you donate will be stored in a central location and distributed by school social workers to students with the greatest need.

**Over 26,000 school supplies** were collected through the Classroom Collection Campaign last year, and our goal is to surpass that this year! These supplies ensure that roughly **3,000 Alamance-Burlington School System students** in need are supplied with basic tools necessary for a successful school year.
