- 4. Provide Career Accelerator Program website update and management services and recommend system enhancements to accomplish goals and objectives.
- 5. Provide digital marketing services that leverage existing platforms, paid advertising, SEO, and social media management.
- 6. Opportunities to connect with the English- and Spanish-speaking populations in Alamance County through appropriate translated collateral.

Responses to this Request of Qualifications (RFQ) shall include the following:

- Experience and Capabilities: Describe the experience and capabilities of assessing target markets, communicating effective messages, and providing measurable results for future improvements. Respondents should also highlight their capacity for multi-media production, especially photography, that can be used for print, web, social media, and other forms of advertising to best connect with community members.
- <u>Key Staff Assigned to the Project</u>: Provide a resume summary and link that accurately details the respondent's work experience, the timeline of responsibilities, missions, and goals. It is also recommended that the respondent share any certifications or professional licenses that confirm their professional capacity to fulfill the scope of services outlined above.

Consultant Selection

The Alamance Chamber will establish and facilitate a Selection Committee for the evaluation of qualifications submitted by respondents responding to the RFQ. The proposals will be evaluated and ranked based on the **Selection Criteria** outlined below. The Alamance Chamber may ask the topranked respondent(s) to attend a presentation and/or interview opportunity as part of the evaluation process. At the conclusion of the evaluation process, respondents will be ranked in priority order with the highest-ranking respondent(s) being selected to negotiate a contract with Alamance Chamber. If Alamance Chamber elects to negotiate a contract with a selected respondent or respondents, the Alamance Chamber reserves the right to negotiate such terms and conditions of the contract, including, but not limited to scope, role, price, and staffing which may be in the best interests of the Alamance Chamber. Certified Minority Business Enterprise/Women's Business Enterprise companies (MBA/WBE) General or sub-contractor are encouraged to respond.

Providing and maintaining adequate insurance coverage is a material obligation of the vendor under the contract. We may request proof of insurance coverage from the vendor prior to contract award. Vendors shall be responsible for providing and maintaining commercial insurance, of the type and amount listed below:

- Minimum Coverage of \$250,000 of worker's compensation employer's liability insurance
- Minimum \$500,000 coverage of commercial general liability insurance
- Automobile liability insurance minimum coverage of \$250,000 for bodily injury and property damage; \$250,000 for un/underinsured; and \$2500 medical payment coverage.

The selected respondent shall provide written proof of contractual liability insurance, comprehensive general liability insurance, workers compensation insurance, pollution coverage insurance, and professional liability insurance for Directors and Officers for errors and omissions.
