Organized by the Alamance Chamber, this campaign is designed to support students by supplying items needed for a successful school year. The supplies you donate will be stored in a central location and distributed by school social workers to students with the greatest need.

Top supply needs for the 2026-27 school year include composition books, expo markers, scissors, mechanical pencils, bookbags, colored pencils, plastic pocket folders (no prongs), markers, kleenex, disinfectant wipes, deodorant, shampoo/conditions, underwear, lice kits, laundry detergent pods, and hand sanitizer.

Over 25,000 school supplies were collected through the Classroom Collection Campaign last year, and our goal is to surpass that this year! These supplies ensure that thousands of Alamance-Burlington School System students in need are supplied with basic tools necessary for a successful school year.
